## LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING Wednesday, February 3, 2021 6pm

### MINUTES

Meeting convened at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Mowatt, Commissioner Diaz and Commissioner Dawicki were present.

The next license commission meeting was confirmed for March 24, 2021

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the minutes of January 6, 2021.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the minutes of November 9, 2020.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

1. Hutghi's Corporation d/b/a Hutgi's at the Nook, 8 Franklin Street, Westfield, MA requesting a change of officers/directors and issuance/transfer of stock/new stockholder.

Attorney Neil Phillips and owner Kevin Gebo were present on the teleconference.

Chairman Mowatt read the legal ad into the minutes.

The office manager stated that the application is in order.

Attorney Neil Phillips stated that this is an officer change and issuance/transfer of stock. Kevin Gebo is buying out some of the owners who are looking to sell.

Kevin Gebo stated the following:

- He first opened the business with six partners.

- He is reducing the ownership and buying out the partners who do not want to be invested in the business anymore.
- The liquor manager will still be the same individual.

Commissioner Dawicki stated this looks like a straight forward application.

Commissioner Diaz agreed and stated that he has been running a good business.

No one spoke in favor or opposition of the transfer.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the change of officers and issuance/transfer of stock.

Attorney Phillips thanked the office manager Kimberly Sienkiewicz for all the help and making this a smooth process.

## **REGULAR MEETING:**

1. Chet Zymroz, owner of Charm Auto requesting a transfer of his Class 2 Auto License to a new location.

Chet Zymroz was present on the teleconference call and stated the following:

- He is looking to transfer his class 2 auto license from 766 Southampton Road to 969 Southampton Road.
- The location has an office on the property and 26 spots for car sales and customer cars.
- He will be using the repair location on site which is Pro Auto and he will also be using his mechanic in Southampton.

The office manager stated that the application is in order.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the transfer of the Class 2 Auto License.

Chet Zymroz thanked the office manager, Kim Sienkiewicz for going above and beyond to help with coordinating other departments to achieve this transfer request.

2. Westfield-West Springfield Lodge of Elks, Inc., 56 Franklin Street, Westfield requesting a change of officer/director and change of liquor manager.

- They have had some officers resign and some that no longer officers of the lodge.
- They are looking to change those officers with new members.
- Scott Hampton, the liquor manager has resigned.
- They would like to request a change of liquor manager to Stephanie Nunez.
- Stephanie has been a bartender for the club for many years.
- She understands all the laws and knows what she is getting herself into by becoming the liquor manager of record..
- Stephanie, along with all the other bartenders and officers are TIPS certified.

The office manager stated that the application is in order.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the change of coporate officers and change of liquor manager to Stephanie Nunez.

Christopher Chistolini thanked the office manager Kim Sienkiewicz for her patience and help with this application process.

3. Brandy Latshaw, d/b/a Jasmeine Moonson, 598 Granville Road requesting a fortune teller license.

Brandy Latshaw was present on the teleconference call and stated the following:

- She currently does Tarot Readings through Etsy.
- She has been doing this for ten years and did not know she needed a license until she called the office asking for a business certificate.
- Tarot Card readings are done on line.
- There will be no customers coming to her house.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the fortune teller license

4. Krause, LLC, d/b/a Rain, 252 Elm Street, Gabriel Krause, owner requesting a d/b/a name change.

The office manager stated that she received in paperwork requesting a d/b/a change from Rain to Gabe's 252.

A motion was made by Chairman Mowatt, seconded and unanimously VOTED to approve the d/b/a request.

5. The office manager stated that all 2021 renewals have been submitted. There is no licensee outstanding.
